Reception

It should draw out the excitement and joy of the Easter season by reflecting on the emotions of those discovering the empty tomb. Easter is the most important and joyous of seasons. The tasks and discussions should reflect that. The multi-faith element identifies Hinduism as a religion.

What do you think the friends of Jesus said when they saw the empty tomb?

How do we show that Jesus is alive today?

Why do we give thanks and praise at Easter?
