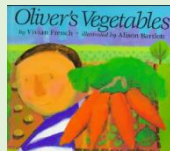

We will name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas. We will be able to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans.

We will learn new vocabulary such as:

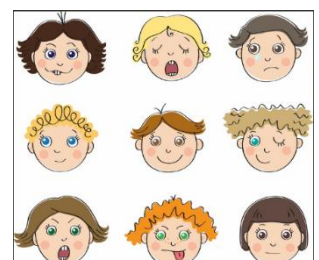
