We will learn new vocabulary such as:

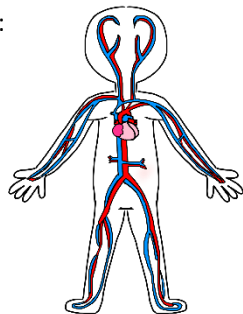
- Primary and Secondary sources
